WHAT IS A VOTED PPEL?

A voted Physical Plant and Equipment Levy (PPEL) is a voter-approved levy that generates funds a school district can use for infrastructure and equipment repairs, purchases, and improvements. Funds may be used only for these purposes.

On **Tuesday, March 5, 2024**, Fairfield Community School District voters will consider approving the district's PPEL. If the measure passes, the voted PPEL will be in place through June 2036 at a rate of \$1.34 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. FCSD's current voted PPEL of \$0.67 will sunset in June 2026 without voter approval.

WHAT IF THE VOTED PPEL IS APPROVED?

With an approved PPEL, the district would prioritize the most urgent and required needs, including:

- School bus replacement
- School security and safety
- Technology infrastructure
- Roof repairs and replacement
- HVAC system maintenance
- Grounds equipment
- Classroom fixtures and furniture

PROPERTY TAX IMPACT

Increasing FCSD's voted PPEL rate to \$1.34 would result in an increase of approximately \$43/year on a residential home with an assessed value of \$150,000, \$46/year on a \$150,000 commercial property, and \$226/year on 320 acres of agricultural property.
